To qualify for the RST exemption, the vehicle must be gifted by a qualifying family member and be able to prove that the donor paid the Manitoba sales tax on the Fair Value of the vehicle or that they had received it tax exempt.

The following list shows what is required for gifting a vehicle:

- ◆ Spouse
- ◆ Mother/Father
- ◆ Son/ Daughter
- ◆ Brother/Sister (Requires Certificate of Inspection & RST)
- ◆ Grandson/ Granddaughter (Requires Certificate of Inspection)
- ◆ Mother-In-Law/ Father-In-Law (Requires Certificate of Inspection)
- ◆ Daughter-In-Law/ Son-In-Law (Requires Certificate of Inspection)
